You'll be pleased to hear that our Tanzanian house mamas, children and labourers are progressing well during our temporary return home. While building is on hold, fw has employed our labourers as guards of Kesho Leo and the volunteer village. The house mamas are still receiving lessons (via fw volunteer nurse, Fran) and the children are being taught by Tanzanian teacher's aide, Lucas. Labourers and mamas are still receiving their wage or allowance, and the children and mamas are offered a nutritious meal each day. fw staff will return in early August.
