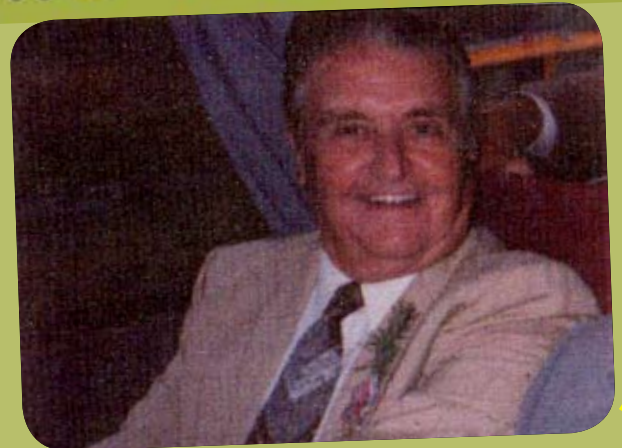
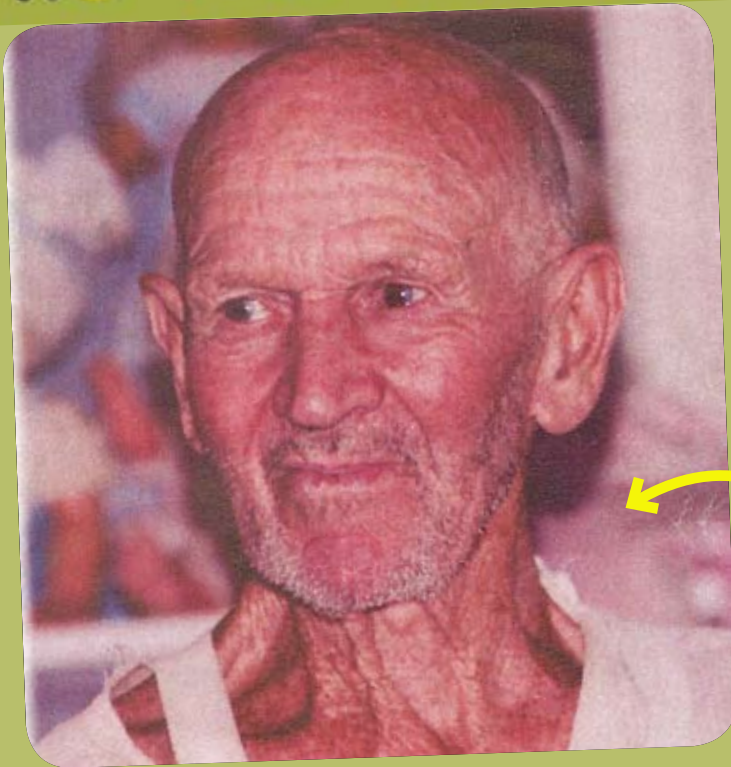
Meet the Fochtas
